






## **Cultivating Community Generosity**

The Foundation was able to distribute over \$5 million in grants from our more than 174 unique funds, which is an incredible leap from the \$3 million achieved in the previous year.

## **Enhancing Collaboration**

Northshare is one of NCF's Civic Initiatives, as we offer a collaborative workspace for the region's nonprofits. Whether calling it their office home or participating in networking and educational opportunities, the possibilities are endless. Since opening in 2017, Northshare has hosted over 5,400 visitors.

# **Focusing on the Changemakers**

The third Chevron Community Fellows Program included a diverse group of community leaders who worked on collaborative projects, improved upon their development skills, and fostered new relationships.

## **Strategizing for the Future**

Regional Advisory Councils were established to focus efforts across the areas we serve through a dynamic, strategic planning process. Councils will address the most pressing needs identified by community leaders from each area.

## **Providing New Pathways**

The Foundation works closely with nonprofits to provide opportunities to amplify their mission. In 2023, NCF launched the Giving Store, an online platform for community members to support NCF's nonprofit partners' programs and services at low-dollar amounts—embodying the spirit of inclusivity for ALL who want to give back. This is only Phase One of the Giving Store, as encompassing volunteerism is on the horizon.
